2016 - Traveling and Setting New Intentions

Dear Shimmering Sounds Community,

Each year seems to have a theme, a flavor of learning in the palette of life.

2016 was a year of forced learning in a way. Not just life lessons and inward transformation, but a lot of people transitioned from their physical form.

Personally, I lost more friends and family members this year than combined in the last ten years.

The Foundation gave free John of God crystal bed sessions, free sound healing sessions, spiritual cleanses, audio recordings, free introductory classes on sound and the Living Soul, contributed to local events on Oahu, including Peace Boat events with the Women of Waianae (a scholarship program for women), Unity Church, as well as regional peace events. The foundation also gave sound healing circles and sessions for free in China, Taiwan, California, Virginia, Pennsylvania, Arizona, Hawaii and other states on the Mainland.

This acceleration of severe injury and illness with clients and students, was quite noticeable.


Most of my international tours and trips are usually three to four weeks at the most. This year I was on tour for six weeks straight. My work time was doubled in China, which was fantastic, in that people expressed they felt more connection with the sound, because the sessions were extended from 40 minutes to 100 minutes. This gave me time to not only present a different teaching topic each day, but also to offer a deeper connection with the sound.

Taiwan was very similar. There were sometimes that 20 percent of the people in the group workshops were dealing with cancer. One person even took a train a few hours to come to Kaohsiung directly after chemo to come to a sound healing circle. I also



presented a two-day sound healing level one class to over a hundred students. This is the first time ever that so many people received sound healing education in Taiwan. This officially brought sound healing to this beautiful island.

Though the trip was highly successful, and we have been invited back to both countries later in 2017, my fatigued body protested. It was too much. I am used to having a storage of healing energy, of healing power, inside me, and when I need to tap into that, it is there. This is how it works with everyone. When someone gets ill, they start to use the healing power that is stored inside themselves. In the Kaballah, it is called the Sephiroth, or the Tree of Life. Anytime we meditate or pray with certain frequencies, we literally activate the dormant DNA inside of ourselves, and the dormant photons and DNA start to awaken. When that happens, we can literally tap into Light, waiting to work on our behalf. DNA not only creates the physical building blocks of Life, it also talks. It has a language. It communicates. This is one of the wonders of sound. Sound literally activates our dormant DNA.



This is why, after years and years of doing healing work, many therapists start to get sick. They have given away more healing energy than they have stored.

Well, with ten flights in eight days at the end of my trip, (one flight on a plane equals more than six hours of radiation from a regular X-ray) I was out of juice. I started thinking about a decade of traveling, being a sound missionary in a sense, and having literally worked with thousands of people. It has been the best part of my life, truly. And yet now, I can feel my heart and physical form are telling me it is time to share the Dharma in a new way, which will mean the Foundation will be taking on a new role in its transition.

This year, I will be focusing on my writing. This is my primary Dharma, as well as teaching sound healing and the Living Soul Spiritual Development Course, created by Master Dr. Mitchell Gibson. Healing is about raising consciousness, and it is time to get back to walking my talk, instead of just walking the walk.

I love playing the bowls, and I have always loved music. And these things are coming back to me for the simple love of music. However right now, the foundation will be less involved in these activities until my book is complete. It is time to look at the bigger

picture and focus on what can help even more people, understanding the Dharma of the Living Soul and its relationship to sound, music, and vibration.

This information has been tucked away in mystery schools. Very little of it is accessible to the Public. I am feeling a calling and have started to write a book that I hope is not only informative, sharing ancient knowledge and wisdom, but in a format that will take you to another world, and tickle your soul with a yearning to know more.



We also are setting the intention to set up a more permanent temple in Hawaii. Once the book has been birthed, we will share more on that manifestation.

In the meantime, thank you for your being a part of our sound journey.


Our Mission:
