2017 - A Year of Purification and Relocation

Dear Shimmering Sounds Community,

2017 was a year of deep purification, helping me realize how critical it is to get this lesson. Humbly, I am hoping by sharing my experience, that it helps someone else evolve within the mystery of the human body and the human soul.



After my trip to China and Taiwan last year, I noticed my energy was almost nonexistent. When I make these trips to Asia, it usually takes me about a month to be able to do sound healing work again. It takes a tremendous amount of energy to organize, pack, get my teaching lessons together, and hop on the plane, come back, unpack, rest and catch up with having been gone. After a month of solid work without a break, it took seven flights in ten days to finally arrive back in Honolulu. Too many flights. Too much radiation. It took three months to realize I had radiation sickness from all of those flights. The radiation exacerbated systemic candida that I probably already had, but this put it over the top.

In May, I went back to Crestone to start getting The Dragon House ready to sell, and made an appointment to see Dr. Dean Lloyd, a soul brother, a friend, and a great Chinese medical doctor. He started putting me on a detoxification program, along with several ozone hydrotherapy sessions. After about a month, we then started a candida protocol. At the same time, I was also clearing out some very deep, old emotions, having to do with family, food, money, the works.

This time I cut my work schedule in half, and met my husband for a belated, proper honeymoon/vacation in Bali! That was another lesson about listening deeply to



whether or not we would be ok making this trip during a possible volcanic eruption. Over 185,000 people had been evacuated when our plane landed in Bali.

This time, I was candida free, rested, and humbly, I believe from doing all of this work, the sound work was deeper in China than the previous year. When I saw how much the sound was supporting the meditation practitioners this year, I vowed when I returned to Oahu, I would start a regular sound healing meditation class. So, with the gracious support of the Won Buddhism Educational Center in Makaha, I now have an almost weekly sound healing gathering. (the only time we do not meet is if they have an event or I am traveling for work). This is the first time since moving to Oahu that I have been doing a regular sound healing event. It is connecting me to the community in ways that I could not imagine.

The Foundation has taken a slight sabbatical in 2017 as I deal with my own recovery from all of the travel, and as I continue writing. With the sale of The Dragon House in Crestone, the board and I have made plans to relocate The Shimmering Sounds Foundation to Hawaii. After much research and advisement from our virtual assistant, Scott Schumacher, we'll be keeping the original non-profit in Colorado, but will register as a "foreign entity" doing business in Hawaii. We have gotten word from our friend and colleague, Rita Roberts, that she will agree to be our registered agent in Monte Vista, Colorado. This was the best agreed upon course, as we did not wish to have to dissolve one non-profit organization to then again start another.

The board agreed that we would change our fiscal agent address at the time of our 2018 annual filing with the State of Colorado, and then apply for the foreign corporation status in Hawaii. As an all-volunteer board, and a small non-profit, we are cherishing the slower pace in allowing us to have a smooth transition to setting up in Hawaii.
